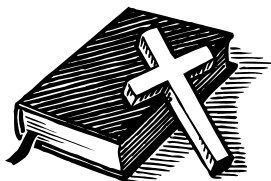

Rene' Pache says in The Person and Work of the Holy Spirit: The subject of the Holy Spirit is of extreme importance. We all need his presence and power, and without Him it would be utterly impossible for us to live the Christian life and serve God." Charles C. Ryrie adds in Basic Theology, "Many people have labeled the 20th century as the century of the Holy Spirit." Dr. Dwight Pentecost says in the The Divine Comforter, the Person and Work of the Holy Spirit: "Personal, intimate fellowship between the believer and the Spirit is essential for spiritual growth."

Make plans to join us on Wednesday nights at 6:30pm for Adult Bible Study (ABS). On May 4, we began a new series on the Work and Ministry of the Holy Spirit. This will be an exhaustive and thorough study of everything the Bible says about the Holy Spirit: His personality, His deity, His ministry to Church age saints, His work in the Old Testament, His ministry to Israel, His ministry during the Tribulation and Millennial Kingdom, and His gifts including dreams and visions, healings, miracles, and speaking in tongues.
