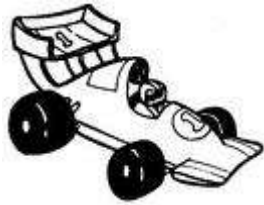

COMMUNITY CONNECTON

Pastor Jeff is still looking for two people to join Pauline and him across the street at DD Johnston Elementary to lead the after school Bible club for Child Evangelism Fellowship. The club will meet October, November, December, February, March and April, on Thursdays from 3-4pm. Jesus told His disciples in Matthew 9, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest." Jesus did not say this because there was a shortage of workers, but because there were plenty of workers available, but few of them were willing. If we cannot raise up four workers, then this harvest will remain in the field. Prayerfully consider serving in this way.

Congregational Scripture Reading

- A. For even as the body is one and yet has many members, and all the members of the body though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ.
- B. For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.
- A. For the body is not one member, but many. If the foot says,
- B. “Because I am not a hand, I am not a part of the body,”
- A. It is not for this reason any the less a part of the body. And if the ear says,
- B. “Because I am not an eye, I am not a part of the body,”
- A. It is not for this reason any the less a part of the body. If the whole body were an eye, where would the hearing be? If the whole were hearing, where would the sense of smell be?
- B. But now God has placed the members, each one of them, in the body, just as He desired. If they were all one member, where would the body be? But now there are many members but one body.

- A. And the eye cannot say to the hand
- B. “I have no need of you,” or again the head to the feet, “I have no need of you.”
- A. On the contrary, it is much truer that the members of the body which appear to be weaker are necessary; and those members of the body that appear to be less honorable, are more honorable, and those members of the body that appear to be less presentable are more presentable, though the more presentable members have no need of them.
- B. But God has so composed the body, giving more abundant honor to that member which lacked, so that there may be no divisions in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.
- A. And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it.
- B. Now we are Christ’s body, and individually members of it.
