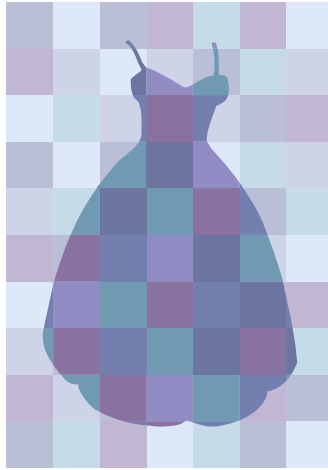

Some special thanks are in order. Thank you to:

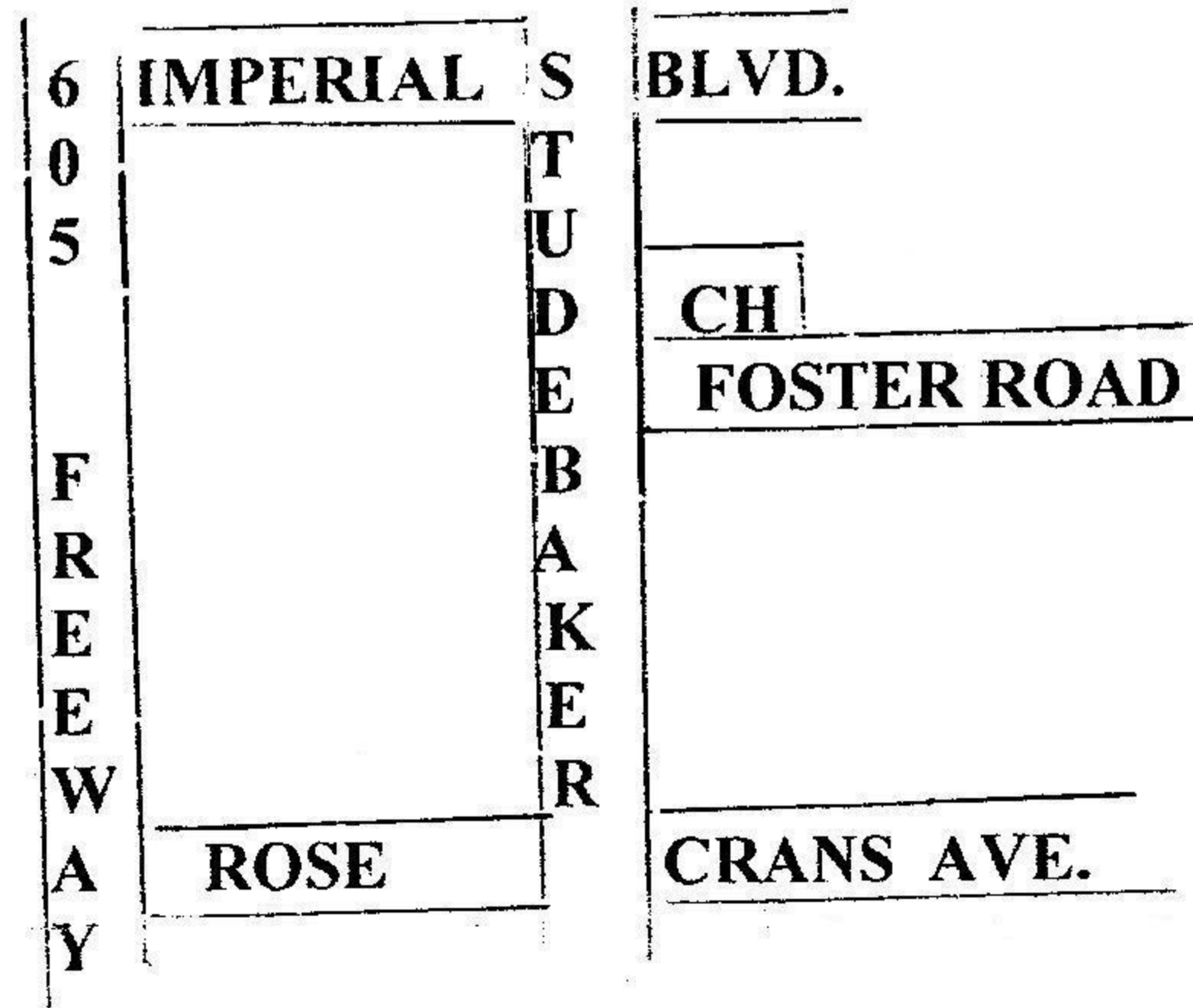
1. Our Heavenly Father for His unfailing faithfulness;
