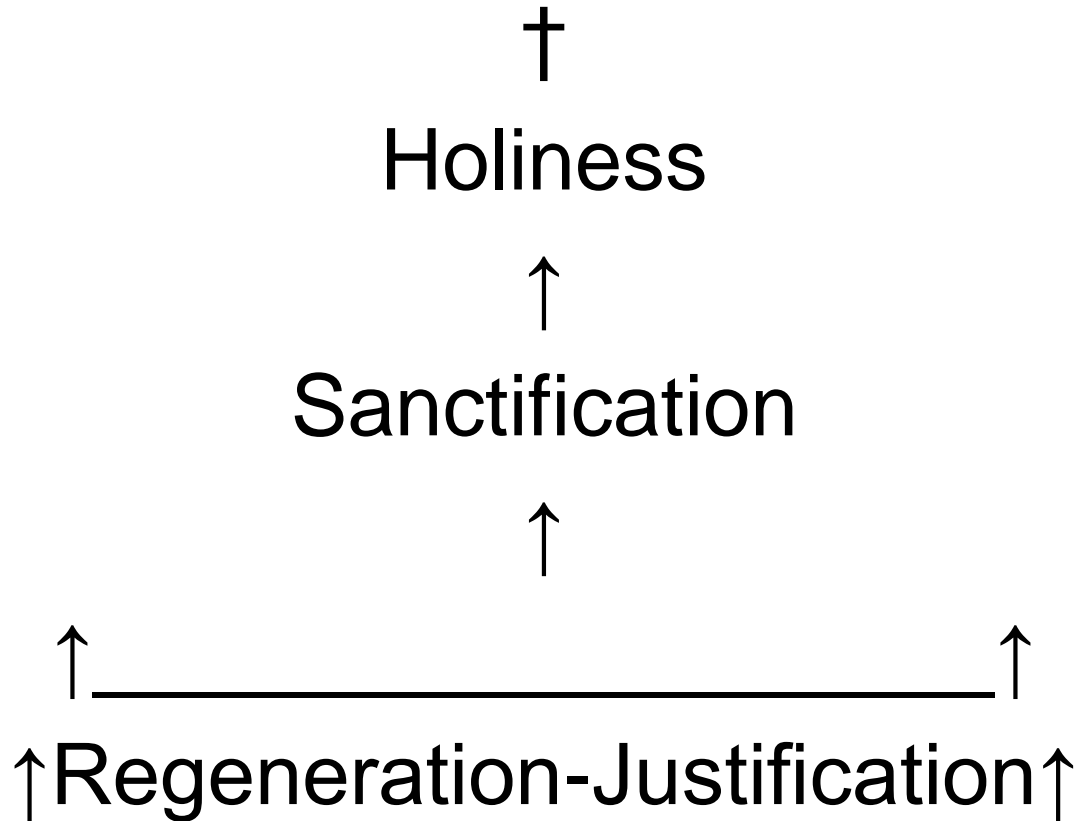
Canaan: Flowing Land

We Must Know

Know:

- a. United with Christ, 6:3-5
- b. Body of sin is dead, 6:6-8
- c. Death no longer rules, 6:9-10
