1. \_\_\_\_\_ “holy ones; every believer in Jesus”
2. \_\_\_\_\_ “good news; of salvation”
3. \_\_\_\_\_ “to rescue; to deliver to safety”
4. \_\_\_\_\_ “condition of perfectly obeying God’s perfect Law; and perfectly conforming to God’s perfect character”
5. \_\_\_\_\_ “to trust in; rely on; have faith in”
6. \_\_\_\_\_ “belief, assurance, confidence in reality of the future”
7. \_\_\_\_\_ “not an impulsive outburst of anger, but a settled determined response of a righteous God against sin”
8. \_\_\_\_\_ “a reversal; to turn away from; move in the opposite direction
9. \_\_\_\_\_ “rules, regulations, commandments, guidelines people follow to gain favor with God; especially Jews & the commandments God gave Moses on Mt. Sinai”
10. \_\_\_\_\_ “payment of ransom to free a slave; Christ paid ransom for on cross for sinners”

11. \_\_\_\_\_ “to appease or satisfy God’s offended holiness with a sacrifice acceptable to God; only Christ could do this for sinners”
12. \_\_\_\_\_ “a great Jewish man the Jews cling to as an example of gaining favor with God by a human good work; proven wrong by Paul”
13. \_\_\_\_\_ “a legal declaration by God that man is in right standing before Him through Christ; a one time event at moment of salvation”
14. \_\_\_\_\_ “not an internal sense of calm and serenity, but the condition of no longer being at war with God”
15. \_\_\_\_\_ “the undeserved mercy and favor of God to sinners”
16. \_\_\_\_\_ “certainty and confidence of something promised, but not yet realized by personal experience; fulfilled in heaven”
17. \_\_\_\_\_ “to bring two warring parties back together in peace; Christ brought God and sinful man back together at the cross”
18. \_\_\_\_\_ “to err morally; to miss the mark; an offense”
19. \_\_\_\_\_ “separation from God; eternal torment in Lake of Fire”
20. \_\_\_\_\_ “holy, pure; life-long process of Christian spiritual growth”
