2. A **faithful** man; (1:1)
3. A **Word** man. (1:8)

A **faithful** man: (1:1)

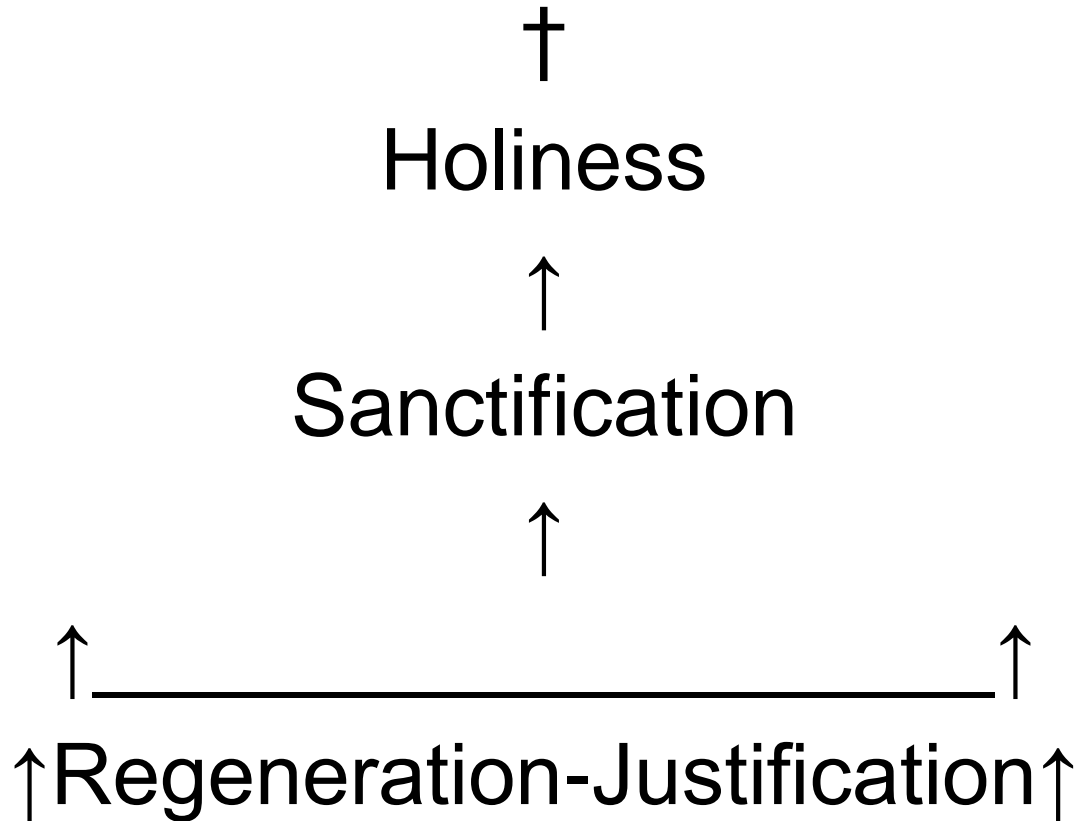
Before greatness was 40 years of

A **Word** man: (1:8)

Obeying God's Word = SUCCESS!

Foundation & Superstructure



We Must Know

Know:

- a. United with Christ, 6:3-5
- b. Body of sin is dead, 6:6-8
- c. Death no longer rules, 6:9-10

We Must Count The Facts As True To Ourselves

Count: “consider, reckon” 6:11
“conclude, reason”

Absolute confidence in the truth;
Affects actions and decisions.
“Keep on counting!”

Present Myself Alive (13-15)

1. “Instruments” = “weapons, military”
2. Continuous presenting;
Once-for-all presenting
3. “Present” = “to hand over”

Present Myself

4. A promise (14)

Sin won't dominate you!

5. A transition: a single act of sin. (15)

God forbid!

Obey the Word (16-23)

1. “Serve/Slave” used 8x

Matthew 6:24

“No man can serve two masters.”

Choose your master.

Obey the Word

2. “Form of Teaching” = “craftsman’s mold”

Romans 12:2; 2 Timothy 1:13; Titus 2:1;
1:9; 1 Peter 2:2

3. Sin’s appetite only grows when fed (19).

Obey the Word

4. Turn it around (20)
5. “Benefit” = “fruit, results” (21-22)
6. The end is eternal life! (22)
7. A solemn warning (23)
