# Romans

- I. Condemnation: 1:18-3:20
  
- II. Salvation: 3:21-8:39
  - A. Justification: 3:21-5:21
  - B. Sanctification: 6:1-7:25
  - C. Preservation: 8:1-39

# Complete Salvation

1. Justification: Saved immediately from sin's **penalty** (past);
2. Sanctification: Saved progressively from sin's **power** (present);
3. Glorification: Saved ultimately from sin's **presence** (future).

# One Great Contrast; Three Divisions

## 1. Adam and Christ

- 1.The Offense & The Gift (12-15);
- 2.Judgment & Justification (16-19);
- 3.Death & Grace (20-21).

# Five Characteristics

1. Begins with Adam; Ends with Christ;
2. Six Contrasts;
3. Four Kings;
4. Work of Christ as Deep as Adam's ;
5. Work of Christ is Greater.

# The Offense & The Gift

1. Sin did not come in alone;  
Death came in too!
2. Adam was a “type” of Christ (14);
3. Christ’s work was far greater! And free!  
Romans 5:15

# Judgment & Justification

1. A contrast of quantity:

Adam's one sin vs Christ's death for untold sins!

2. Victory: Judgment = reign of death

Justification = reign of life!

2 Timothy 2:12; Revelation  
3:21; 22:5

# Death & Grace

1. Law (or good works) cannot bring eternal life; they only point out our sin;
2. God's grace in Christ is more than fully capable to bring us victory over sin and death!
