# Introduction: The Wrong Way

## Characteristics of Romans 7:

1. Romans 6:14 is key to Romans 6/7;
2. Key word "sin" in Romans 6; key word "law" in Romans 7;
3. Personal pronouns "I, me, my, myself" occur 47x!

# Victorious Christian Life

The victorious Christian life is focused on the cross of Christ, even after salvation.

We must be "cross-eyed" because God is "cross-eyed."

# Law & The Christian (1-6)

The Christian is dead to the law! Done with it forever!

But that's not all: now joined to Christ to bear fruit!

# The Law & Sin (7-13)

## The Law of God:

1. Is good and holy;
2. Reveals sin;
3. Provokes sin;
4. Condemns sin;
5. Kills man.

# The Law & The Carnal Man (14-25)

Key: "I am carnal, fleshly, sensual, opposed to spiritual."

1. I do what I don't want to do (14-17);
2. Nothing good in my flesh (18-20);
3. Evil is present in me (21-25).
